Professor John Stachel holds a Ph.D. in Physics from Stevens Institute of Technology where he did his doctoral work on general relativity. He taught physics at Lehigh University and the University of Pittsburgh before joining the Physics Department of Boston University in 1964. Professor Stachel has written about Einstein and his work for over 40 years and was chosen as the founding editor of *The Collected Papers of Albert Einstein*. He is the author of *Einstein from B to Z* (2002) and has written extensively on problems involving the history and philosophy of science and the Marxist approach to social issues.
